**President of Combustion Associates, Inc. Invited by U.S. Vice
President Biden and Secretary of State John Kerry to luncheon in
honor of Turkish Prime Minister Erdoğan**

CORONA, Calif. May 2013 — On May 16, Combustion Associates, Inc. (CAI) President Kusum Kavia was invited to a special luncheon at the State Department in honor of U.S. Vice President Joseph Biden, Turkish Prime Minister Recep Tayyip Erdoğan, and Secretary of State John Kerry.

The topic of the meeting was to discuss U.S. and Turkish relations.

The special luncheon was followed by the 32nd Annual Conference on U.S.-Turkey Relations. The annual conference focuses on defense and security issues, infrastructure, energy, banking and finance, education, agribusiness, and tourism. Turkey has been one of the fastest growing economies in Europe.

Ms. Kavia is president of CAI, a manufacturer of modular plug and play power systems in the 1 to 25 MW range for industry and developing economies.

The conference on U.S.-Turkey relations is on June 4, and will attract over 600 attendees. Vice President Biden is the conference's keynote speaker. Turkey's Deputy Prime Minister Ali Babacan will deliver the Government of Turkey's keynote address.
